**VASS Checks 50172, 50609 (APC), 51236 and 51611 (OP) amended
Invalid Principal Procedure Code, Inconsistent Sex vs. Primary Procedure
Code, Invalid Primary Procedure Code and Inconsistent Primary Procedure
Code (OPCS) vs. Sex**

OPCS-4 is the Office of Population, Censuses and Surveys Classification of Surgical Operations and Procedures (OPCS) (4th revision). This statistical classification translates into code, operations and surgical procedures that can be carried out on a patient during an episode of health care.

From 1st April 2014 until 31st March 2017, the valid version of OPCS was version 4.7.

On 19th October 2016 NHS Digital published Information Standards Notice SCCI0084 Amd 105/2015, to mandate OPCS v4.8 from 1st April 2017 in NHS England. This implementation timescale is endorsed by the Welsh Information Standards Board for NHS Wales and mandated in [DSCN 2017 / 02](#) for NHS Wales.

Version 4.8 was published by the Clinical Classifications Service of NHS Digital and was introduced across NHS Wales on 1st April 2014.
