This will involve acting as the first point of contact to users for incident resolution; recording calls, logging requests and helping to reach solutions. The role will involve using various technologies to apply first-line fixes and you will work closely with other teams and suppliers to improve services across NHS Wales. Alongside working with this team, you will undertake a Higher Degree Apprenticeship in Cyber Security at Swansea University (UWTSD) commencing in January 2021.

SINGLE RECORD PRODUCT TEAM (1 APPRENTICESHIP POST)

You will proactively assist the test team in ensuring that the software for the Single Record Product is fit for purpose and fulfils the required criteria. You will play a vital role in ensuring that software released for use across NHS Wales works as intended and you will gain expertise in the techniques and strategies used in the testing of web-based and mobile applications. To support your work with this team, you will also undertake a Higher Degree Apprenticeship in Software Development at Swansea University (UWTSD) commencing in January 2021.

This is an exciting opportunity to join an innovative programme while earning a salary (Band 3 salary £19,737). You will have access to a higher degree course specifically chosen for the role and you will be supported by experienced mentors and managers throughout your apprenticeship. As an apprentice working in a rapidly growing sector, you will gain and develop your skills and become a health informatics professional of tomorrow.
