## Cofnod Meddyg Teulu Cymru Welsh GP Record

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The Welsh GP Record enables a range of people supporting your direct care to access a summary of key health information from the records your GP keeps about you. It helps to improve patient safety and quality of care through quicker access to information.

The **summary** information, such your current as

medication, recent test results, your medical history, allergies, etc., is made available to the health professionals treating you, anywhere in Wales. This will help them to make informed decisions about the care they provide you, without you having to remember and repeat this information and is likely to reduce unnecessary repeat tests such as blood tests and x-rays.

The information is only made available to these people in certain settings, such as A&E, GP Out of Hours, Advanced Paramedics and Community Pharmacists, and usually with your permission. Checks are regularly made to ensure no one is looking at the summary information when they shouldn't be.

If you don't want this summary information to be made available outside of your GP practice, please contact your practice to discuss your request.
