News Article: Labour Party members' data hit by cyber incident

The Labour Party has been affected by a "cyber incident" involving its members' data. Labour said it was told on 29 October that it had been affected by the event by a third party firm that handled membership data on its behalf.

News Article: Location data collection firm admits privacy breach

A British firm which sells people's location data has admitted that some of its information was gained without seeking permission from users. Huq uses location data from apps on people's phones, and sells it on to clients, which include dozens of English and Scottish city councils.

Electronic monitoring of home workers by companies is rising sharply, a survey suggests. The government is being urged to toughen the rules - and ban most webcam use.
