The UK Information Commissioner has called on the criminal justice sector to immediately stop collecting excessive amounts of personal information from victims of rape and serious sexual assault cases.

News Article: Report on RTB: Adtech "Biggest Data Breach Ever Recorded," Online Behaviour More Exposed in Countries Without Privacy Regulations

The Irish Council for Civil Liberties (ICCL), a non-profit in operation since 1976, has issued a scathing new report calling the real-time bidding (RTB) adtech industry as a whole the "biggest data breach ever recorded." The report finds that online behaviour is not only constantly and commonly tracked by web-spanning RTB programs, but that the data recorded eventually finds its way to countries all over the world.
