A German company has been ordered to pay a fine under GDPR after using a Google Font, which was leaking IP addresses of visitors to its website to Google, without disclosure to the customer. [Relates to Germany]

Following in the footsteps of the Data Governance Act, the 2021 regulation that established a framework for the handling of non-personal data, the European Commission is moving ahead with a bill that covers connected devices and their associated services.

News Article: Italy fines Clearview AI €20M and orders data deleted

Italy's data protection agency today announced a €20 million penalty for breaches of EU law against the facial recognition firm, Clearview AI, which scrapes selfies off the Internet to amass a database of some 10 billion of faces to power an identity-matching service it sells to law enforcement.
