ICO Fine: ICO takes action against companies over predatory marketing calls targeting elderly, vulnerable people

The Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) today announced fines totalling £405,000 to five companies responsible for over 750,000 unwanted marketing calls targeted at older, vulnerable people. The ICO also issued these companies with enforcement notices that require them to immediately stop making these predatory calls.

Facebook parent company Meta has been fined €17m for breaching EU data privacy laws. It follows an inquiry into 12 data breaches the Irish Data Protection Commission received over a six-month period between 7 June, 2018 and 4 December, 2018.
