**Data Breach Costs Fall for First Time in Five Years**

The IBM report found that customer personally identifiable information (PII) was the most stolen or compromised data type, occurring in 53% of breaches. PII includes tax identity numbers, emails and home addresses, and can be used in identity theft and credit card fraud.

**Charity fined following destruction of irreplaceable personal records**

Subsequent investigation found at the time of the breach there was a limited understanding of data protection law at the charity, which had not implemented relevant policies and procedures or appropriately trained its staff.

**GDPR's 7th anniversary: in the AI age, privacy legislation is still relevant**

As organisations embed AI deeper into their operations, it's time to ask the tough questions around what kind of data we're feeding into AI, who has access to AI outputs, and if there's a breach – what processes we have in place to respond quickly and meet GDPR's reporting timelines.

**What the Cyber Resilience Bill Means for UK Businesses**

The Bill is a wake-up call for organisations in the UK. It builds on the existing NIS (Network and Information Security) Regulations, bringing in new requirements that expand its reach across digital supply chains and other critical sectors.
