**Care home director found guilty of ignoring request for personal information | ICO**

The director of a care home in Bridlington, Yorkshire, has been fined for refusing to respond to a request for a resident’s personal information – known as a subject access request (SAR).

**Pseudonymised data could fall outside data protection law – introducing the “means reasonably likely” assessment**

The Court of Justice of the European Union (CJEU) has delivered its judgment on case C 413/23 P European Data Protection Supervisor (EDPS) v Single Resolution Board (SRB). The CJEU has confirmed that pseudonymised data will not be personal data in all cases.

**Data protection in spotlight as Shein fined €150m for cookie misuse**

The regulator found multiple violations of French data protection law, including placing advertising cookies on users' devices before obtaining consent, providing incomplete information about cookie purposes, and continuing to place cookies even when users clicked "refuse all" or withdrew their consent.
