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Galw ar arweinwyr gofal cymdeithasol i ymrwymo i gofnodion gofal gwell nawr (ICO)

Heddiw (dydd Iau 25 Mehefin) rydym wedi galw ar arweinwyr gofal cymdeithasol i ymrwymo'n gyhoeddus i wella sut mae cofnodion gofal yn cael eu creu, eu trin a'u cyrchu.

Nid oes gan un o bob deg sefydliad hyfforddiant diogelu data GDPR ar waith, yn ôl ymchwil

Nid yw bron i un o bob tri gweithiwr cydymffurfiaeth a diogelu data proffesiynol (31%) yn gwybod pryd y gwnaeth eu sefydliad adolygu ei brif asesiadau risg GDPR ddiwethaf. Mae hynny yn ôl canfyddiadau diweddaraf arolwg o 198 o weithwyr proffesiynol a gynhaliwyd ddiwedd mis Mai 2026 gan VinciWorks, gan nodi wyth mlynedd ers i GDPR ddod i rym.

One in ten organisations have no GDPR data protection training in place, research finds

Nearly one in three compliance and data protection professionals (31%) do not know when their organisation last reviewed its main GDPR risk assessments. That is according to the latest findings from a survey of 198 professionals carried out at the end of May 2026 by VinciWorks, marking eight years since GDPR came into force.
