Hyundai Announces Security Breach, Which May Have Leaked Social Security Numbers

Hyundai is warning customers of a data breach that reportedly affected millions of people. A report from Forbes shows that Hyundai AutoEver, an IT subsidiary of the greater Hyundai Group, experienced a security breach earlier this year.

Public Accounts Committee criticises MoD over Afghan data breach

MoD also failed to do enough to improve its processes, guidance and culture in response to this risk, nor to learn lessons from multiple data breaches over successive years. It was disclosed in August 2025 that there were 49 separate data breaches at the unit handling applications from Afghan citizens to relocate to the UK.

UK faces four major cyberattacks weekly

Recent cyberattacks have inflicted substantial financial damage on British businesses. Marks & Spencer reported losses of £300 million, while the Co-op Group sustained £206 million in damages. Jaguar Land Rover also experienced breaches, though specific losses were not disclosed.
