[UK government and Information Commissioner’s Office sign agreement to firm-up data protection](#)

The ICO has agreed to produce “timely and relevant guidance, codes of practice, advice notes, opinions, and audits that support the government and the public sector to use people’s data safely”. It also said it would be “transparent” with the public on holding organisations to account for any future breaches and would “share insights [with government] on any trends and potential risks that the ICO has seen in its work

[Instagram denies breach after many receive emails asking to reset password](#)

Cybercriminals stole the sensitive information of 17.5 million Instagram accounts, including usernames, physical addresses, phone numbers, email addresses, and more," it claimed in a post on X, along with a screenshot of a password reset email from Instagram.

[Eurail Interail systems breached: customer data exposed](#)

A significant data security breach has impacted Eurail's Interrail systems, potentially exposing sensitive personal information of customers across Europe, according to Cybernews. The incident, which also affects participants in the EU's DiscoverEU travel initiative, involved unauthorized access to a database containing names, email and home addresses, phone numbers, dates of birth, and, in some cases, copies of passports, identity documents, and bank account details.
