Understanding the Data (Use and Access) Act: what businesses need to know

DUAA introduces several changes aimed at streamlining data protection laws to make compliance easier while maintaining robust privacy standards. It does this by making several changes to the United Kingdom General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR), Data Protection Act 2018 (DPA), and the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations 2003 (PECR).

The impacted data reportedly includes details of how much money individual customers have spent with the brands. ShinyHunters has claimed to have harvested data relating to 7.4 million unique email addresses.

Two teenagers charged over Transport for London cyber attack

Both appeared at Westminster Magistrates Court on Thursday afternoon charged with conspiring together to commit unauthorised acts against TfL, under the Computer Misuse Act. TfL wrote to around 5,000 customers to say there may have been unauthorised access to their personal information such as bank account numbers and sort codes.
