The Data (Use and Access) Act 2025 (DUAA) has now received Royal Assent. This new legislation updates key aspects of data protection law, making it easier for UK businesses to protect people’s personal information while growing and innovating their products and services.

[UK ICO Fines 23andMe £2.3m for Data Protection Failings](#)

Embattled genetic testing company 23andMe has been fined £2.3m (\$3.1m) by the UK’s privacy regulator for failing to protect customers’ special category data following a 2023 cyber-attack...According to the UK’s Information Commissioner’s Office (ICO), the campaign ran from April to September that year, exploiting reused login credentials.

[UK government confirms massive data breach following hack of Legal Aid Agency](#)

Ministry of Justice (MoJ) confirmed on Monday that hackers had “accessed a large amount of information” from people who had applied for legal aid, potentially including their criminal histories.
