**UK Government promises to strengthen data protection**

The commitments include creating a central, coordinated approach for managing cross-government data protection accountability and compliance; establishing a dedicated team who will set consistent standards and respond swiftly to risks; rolling out new information management training for all civil servants.

**Former police CCTV operator admits coercive control and data offences**

In March 2025, he admitted to knowingly obtaining or disclosing personal data without consent. He had denied coercive control until 20 October, when he changed his plea to guilty two days before his trial at Swansea Crown Court.

**Police Scotland Hit by Multiple Data Breaches Involving Sensitive Personal Information**

Compromised information included names, addresses, dates of birth, contact details, photographs, fingerprints, health data, and vehicle registration details. Several of the breaches also involved failures to meet GDPR requirements for fair, transparent, and secure processing of personal data. **Relevance – Scotland**
