Privacy non-profit organization NOYB - European Center for Digital Rights has taken up a player's case against Ubisoft, alleging its data collection practices have "no valid legal basis." The complainant also takes issue with the fact Far Cry Primal could not be played offline or without setting up, and logging into, an Ubisoft account, stating they were "astonished that it was impossible to play a single-player game, offering no online functionalities" without an internet connection.

The ICO have fined AFK Letters Co Ltd (AFK) £90,000 for making more than 95,000 unsolicited marketing calls to people registered with the Telephone Preference Service (TPS), in a clear breach of electronic marketing laws. AFK Letters is a company which writes letters seeking compensation and refunds for its customers.
