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Cyfraith cwynion diogelu data newydd bellach ar waith

Rhaid i bob sefydliad bellach roi ffordd glir i bobl godi cwyn diogelu data, cydnabod hynny o fewn 30 niwrnod, ymchwilio'n briodol a chyfleu'r canlyniad.

Dirwy o £300,000 i gwmni o Fanceinion am blagio pobl mewn dyled gyda dros 5.5 miliwn o negeseuon testun anghyfreithlon

Mae Swyddfa'r Comisiynydd Gwybodaeth wedi rhoi dirwy i KRA Consultancy Ltd (KRA) gwerth £300,000 ar ôl iddo dargedu pobl oedd eisoes mewn trafferthion ariannol gyda negeseuon testun sothach anghyfreithlon – gan gynnwys negeseuon beiliaid ffug.

Nid yw chwilfrydedd yn esgus: diogelu data cleifion mewn gofal iechyd

Pan fydd pobl yn ceisio gofal meddygol, maen nhw'n rhannu rhywfaint o'r wybodaeth bersonol fwyaf sensitif amdany'n nhw eu hunain. Maen nhw'n gwneud hynny allan o angenrheidrwydd, a chan ymddiried y bydd mewn dwylo diogel. Pan gaiff cofnodion meddygol eu cyrchu heb reswm dilys, mae'r ymddiriedaeth honno'n cael ei pheryglu.

New data protection complaints law now in force

All organisations must now give people a clear way to raise a data protection complaint, acknowledge it within 30 days, investigate appropriately and communicate the outcome.

Manchester firm fined £300,000 for bombarding people in debt with over 5.5 million unlawful texts

The ICO have fined KRA Consultancy Ltd (KRA) £300,000 after it targeted people who were already in financial difficulty with unlawful spam texts – including fake bailiff messages.
