**Bristol City Council issued with enforcement notice over failures to respond to data requests**

The ICO have issued an enforcement notice to Bristol City Council (BCC) for failing to comply with its legal obligations to respond to people who asked for the personal information the council held on them – known as a subject access request (SAR).

**Children's names, pictures and addresses stolen in nursery chain hack**

An employee at one of the nurseries confirmed they have been notified of a data breach. Cyber-security firm Check Point described the targeting of nurseries as "an absolute new low". It has published a sample of data there including pictures and profiles of 10 children from the stolen data set.

**ICO consults on draft changes to how data protection complaints are handled**

The Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) is consulting on draft changes to how they handle data protection complaints. It sets out the proposed framework to assess and determine the extent to which it is appropriate to investigate each complaint.
