### [Vulnerable children's details at risk in data breach](#)

The cybersecurity failure poses "a potential safeguarding risk to children" and relates to young people looked after by Cardiff council, according to the Local Democracy Reporting Service.

Members of Cardiff council's governance and audit committee were told about the data breach by a council official.

### [StreamElements Data Breach Alert: User Information Reportedly Leaked on Dark Web](#)

The reported breach specifically impacts the StreamElements Merch store. However, it remains unclear whether content creators who use the platform's other services have also been affected, in addition to customers of the Merch store. The alleged breach appears to be extensive, with the compromised data including personally identifiable information (PII).

### [Biometric technology in schools: Lessons learned from ICO regulation](#)

New research shows that half of schools regularly use artificial intelligence but that many are putting pupil data and biometric information at risk. Data protection expert Claire Archibald describes a dedicated process for the safe adoption of AI-driven technologies.
