£355,880.10 confiscation order secured following proceeds of crime hearing

The ICO have secured a £355,880.10 confiscation order against former Manchester motor insurance worker, who was previously found guilty of securing unauthorised access to personal information on his work computer systems for his own financial gain.

Canvas Data Breach: What Students, Parents, and Faculty Need to Know

A hacking group known as ShinyHunters claimed responsibility for the breach. According to reports, the group threatened to leak data connected to thousands of schools and millions of users unless a ransom was paid. The hackers breached Canvas by sending malicious code to the platform's support representatives.

Glasgow-based energy company fined £160,000 for making unsolicited marketing calls

The ICO have fined a Glasgow-based company £160,000 for making over 700,000 unsolicited marketing sales calls to numbers registered on the Telephone Preference Service (TPS) and Corporate Telephone Preference Service (CTPS), in a clear breach of law..
