## [Post Office data breach victims to get compensation](#)

The data breach was revealed in June last year when it emerged the personal details of 555 victims of the Horizon IT scandal had been published. The company has now confirmed individual payouts of up to £5,000 with the potential for higher sums for those who want to pursue a further claim.

## [London council reprimanded for exposing personal details of 6,528 people for almost two years](#)

The personal data breach occurred when the council responded to a freedom of information (FOI) request made via the WhatDoTheyKnow.com (WDTK) website in October 2021. The response, published on the council's website and WDTK, contained 10 workbooks which included personal information. In total 6,528 people were affected, with 2,342 being children.

## [M&S hit with lawsuit following customer data breach](#)

An M&S spokesperson said: "Importantly, the data does not include useable payment or card details, which we do not hold on our systems, and it does not include any account passwords. There is no evidence that this data has been shared."
