[Pupils' sensitive data shared 'by mistake'](#)

A head teacher has apologised after hundreds of pupils' private data was shared with two parents.

Wellsway School in Keynsham, near Bristol, has been reported to the Information Commissioner's Office after 86,000 lines of sensitive information was emailed to a couple.

[ICO takes action to tackle cookie compliance across the UK's top 1,000 websites](#)

The ICO have announced plans to bring the UK's top 1,000 websites into compliance with data protection law.

The ICO have already assessed the compliance of the top 200 UK websites and communicated concerns to 134 of those organisations, setting out clear regulatory expectations that organisations must comply with the law by giving people meaningful choice on how their personal information is used online.
