The counts for these measures were being sourced from the recently-approved pro-formas.</li> <li>Members noted that there was no measure of total wait times for Part 1; only waits up to 28 or 56 days and over were included.</li> <li>Members assumed that these measures would be output by Health Board of Residence as this had been the currency used within the data submission.</li> </ol>
