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## Reason for Change

The KT31 return, 'Community Contraception and Reproductive Health Services', has provided information on NHS community contraception and reproductive health services activity since 1988. The return has undergone some revisions over the years, the last of which being outlined in DSCN 22/2002.

However, there has never been a suitable description of this return in the dictionary, although it does contain a description of the associated terms and definitions.

The definitions to support this return can be found in the annex to DSCN 22/2002, and also in the Welsh Government annual statistical release, 'NHS Community Contraceptive Services In Wales'.

As the definitions for the KT31 return are available elsewhere, this DDCN is therefore removing all definitions associated with this return from the data dictionary and adding the details of the return itself. This DDCN also introduces a link to the latest KT31 proforma into the dictionary.

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## Description of Change

To introduce the KT31 'Community Contraception and Reproductive Health Service' Return to the NHS Wales Data Dictionary and remove the redundant KT31 definitions.

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## Data Dictionary Version

Where applicable, this DDCN reflects changes introduced by DDCN and/or DSCN since the release of version 4.0 of the NHS Wales Data Dictionary.

The changes introduced by such DDCNs will be published in version 4.1 of the NHS Wales Data Dictionary.

## Changes to Terms (A-Z)

### Contraception

This is the process by which conception (the onset of pregnancy) is prevented.

**Main method chosen:** the main method of contraception chosen at the first contact during the financial year, only one main method \* per client. This should be the main method chosen, or for existing clients, the main method in use.

\* Unless one method is post-coital in which case this may be recorded in addition to the main method.

Main method may be classified:

#### For females

i)	Oral contraceptive Combined preparation Progesterone
(ii)	Intra-uterine device (IUD)
(iii)	Cap, diaphragm
(iv)	Sponge
(v)	Male sheath
(vi)	Female sheath
(vii)	Chemicals
(viii)	Injected contraceptives
(ix)	Rhythm method
(x)	Implant (When available on form to be collected)
(xi)	Female sterilization
(xii)	Other methods
(xiii)	No method provided
(xiv)	Attending for purposes other than contraception

#### For males

(i)	Vasectomy
(ii)	Male sheath
(iii)	Other method
(iv)	No method provided
(v)	Attending for purposes other than contraception

#### Notes:

1. Where a definite choice of vasectomy, female sterilization or intra-uterine device is made, and arrangements for this are put in hand, it is the main method, even though an alternative method may be advised for temporary use.
2. If the client comes in only for post-coital contraceptives then the post-coital method chosen (hormonal or IUD) should be recorded as the main method.
3. If a couple attends together the main method refers only to the partner for whom the main method of contraception was or has been prescribed.
