Reason for Change

On 1st April 2009, the data item 'First Attendance' was retired from the Outpatient Data Set and replaced with the data item 'Attendance Category' via DSCN (2008) 10 (W). The reason for this change was to reflect the inclusion of Pre-Operative Assessment Attendances in the data set.

There was a dependency between the data items 'First Attendance' and 'Priority Type (New Patients)' which was not taken into account in 2009 when the data item changed to 'Attendance Category', this purpose of this DDSN is to retrospectively update the definition for Priority Type (New Patients).

Description of Change

To update the data item 'Priority Type' and its associated definition.

This is the priority of a request for services and is to be recorded for a new attendances only patient, that is, where 'Attendance Category' First Attendance = 1. In the case of services to be provided by a Consultant, it is as assessed by or on behalf of the Consultant.

For a Follow-up Attendance or a Pre-Operative Assessment Attendance, Priority Type must be blank.

Note: Priority Type can be defined more precisely if this is needed for local purposes, as long as the classifications can be mapped back to the national ones. Appointments which have been classified as 'soon' locally must be defined as 'Urgent' in the datasets.
