Reason for Change

Office of Population Censuses and Surveys (OPCS) is a statistical classification which translates operations and surgical procedures into codes. Users of OPCS data such as the NHS Wales Informatics Service (NWIS), the Health and Statistics Unit (HSA), and Welsh Government, will need to modify their analyses and any associated publications to reflect changes introduced by OPCS version release cycles.

The release of OPCS combined codes and titles, metadata file for the Service and NHS system suppliers, and Tables of Equivalences between versions for analysis purposes, are available via the Technology Reference Data Update Distribution (TRUD) Service.
