**Subject:** The addition of code (27) in METHOD of ADMISSION for emergency patients admitted via the NHS Direct Service.

The inclusion of a default N9999998 N9999997 in the Referrer Code for such admissions. The inclusion of RCVLA RVCLA in the referring organisation data field for emergency admissions via NHS Direct Services (Wales).

This code is to be used for any NHS Direct Service site referring within Wales.

**Type of Change:** The current Trust PAS systems will need to update their master-files to include the new code. The PEDW master-files will need to be updated to reflect these code inclusions.

**Reason for Change:** Following the recommendations of the WHIMG which, recognised the need to accurately record the emergency pressures on the service and the routes the patients are taking to obtain access to emergency services in NHS Wales. It has been agreed to include this additional code in Method of Admission, Referrer code and referring Organisation Code for patients admitted via the NHS Direct Wales route.
