Subject:	To correct the All Wales Data Dictionary entry for the data term 'Referrer Code' and 'Referring Organisation Code'
Effective Date:	Immediately
Reason of Change:	The request proposes to include the NHS Direct value for Referrer Code in the Dictionary and to provide clarification of the value to be used for the NHS Direct referring organization code.

Background:

DSCN 38/2001, issued August 2001, was raised to introduce new codes to define NHS Direct referrals (Referrer Code and Referring Organisation Code). These codes were incorrect and the DSCN also omitted the introduction of a new code for Nurse referrals.

DSCN 38/2001 Amendment, also issued August 2001, corrected these errors but still omitted the introduction of a new Referrer Code for Nurse. Added to this, the NHS Wales Data Dictionary was not updated with these values, and remains as it was since before that time.

This has led to confusion within the Trusts regarding what values should be used for referrals from either a Nurse or NHS Direct, and the associated referring organization code.

This DSCN corrects and clarifies the confusion generated by DSCN 38/01 and DSCN 38/01 Amendment.

Impact in Wales:

The Data Dictionary data term definitions for 'Referrer Code' will change to allow for the correct distinction between a referral by a Nurse and a referral via the NHS Direct services.
