Effective Date:	September 2004	
Reason of Change:	Version 2.4 of the Data Dictionary is not clear in defining the waiting times measures for the fitting of a hearing aid.	

Background:

The definition for the removal from the waiting list for the Audiology Service of the Diagnostics and Therapy Service Waiting Times does not state the exact event. Consequently, removal from the waiting list is open to interpretation.Version 2.4 of the Data Dictionary states under 'Audiology' that patients are removed from the waiting list on the day their hearing aid is fitted. Some Audiology clinics regard the end of the wait period as being when the patient has received the final fitting (which could be some time after the first fitting).

As a result of queries received, DSIQ have proposed a change to the text that is currently under the 'Audiology' heading. It should read Patients are 'removed from the waiting list on the day they are fitted **with the first issue of a hearing aid.** All to be reported by referral from consultant or GP'.

Impact in Wales:

Version 2.5 of the Dictionary will contain the explanatory text and should reduce confusion at the Trusts and reduce the number of query calls to IPU.

The proposed change to the Dictionary should provide the basis for helping to reduce waiting times for some Audiology treatments.
