Subject: Data Standards: Marital Status

Effective Date: 1st November 2006

Reason of Change: To bring the Welsh definition in line with England

Background:

1) NHS England DSCN 16/2005 announced enhancements to the definition of data item 'Marital Status'. It was designed primarily to allow for the mandatory reporting of marital status for England's Mental Health Minimum Dataset. It was noticed that, although NHS Wales does not have a Mental Health MDS, current NHS Wales definitions for 'Marital Status' did not cater for reporting the data item where the marital status could not be determined. For this reason, it was decided to introduce the value of "9 – Not Known" to the NHS Wales data item 'Marital Status'. In addition, this change re-aligns the Welsh definition with that of England.

2) In December 2005 the Civil Partnership Act 2004 came into force enabling same-sex couples to obtain legal recognition in their relationship, DSCN 12/2006 introduces a new value to identify civil partnerships.

The e-Government Interoperability Framework (e-GIF) mandates the adoption of XML. A key element in the development of XML schemas is an agreed set of data standards. The Government Data Standards Catalogue (GDSC) sets data standards to be used in the schemas and other interchange processes Catalogue.

From October 2006 the English Commissioning Data Sets will be submitted in XML format. This DSCN declares the new values for the data item Marital Status to comply with the GDSC.

Impact within NHS Wales:

In order for cross border information flows to remain compatible, these new values must be introduced for use by NHS Wales. These new values will be used by NHS England from October 2006 and are already in place by NHS Scotland.

Marital Status

(APC ds99 – Mandatory for Psychiatric Patients Only)

Only collected for patients under the care of a consultant in a psychiatric specialty. This is the legal status of a patient in respect of marriage. This is the legal marital or civil status of a patient.
