Using the data held centrally in the National Community Child Health Database, HSW provide information to the National Public Health Service (NPHS) which they then use to produce the Coverage of Vaccinations Evaluated Rapidly (COVER) Return.

The COVER scheme has been running in England and Wales since 1987. The return follows trends in immunisation uptake in Wales. The report is made available via the NPHS web site and is forwarded to the Health Protection agency for UK comparisons.

The COVER scheme has been running in England and Wales since 1987. The return follows trends in immunisation uptake in Wales. The report is made available via the NPHS web site and is forwarded to the Health Protection agency for UK comparisons.

The return is produced on a quarterly and annual basis from figures extracted from the National Community Child Health Database (NCCHD), local Community Child Health systems (CCH2000). These are collated and regrouped to produce breakdowns by Local Health Boards, as well as all Wales statistics.
