DATA SET CHANGE NOTICE

Introduction

Healthcare Resource Groups (HRGs) are designed to be standard groupings of clinically similar treatments which use common levels of healthcare resource.

The purpose of HRGs is to offer organisations the ability to understand their activity in terms of the types of patients they care for and the treatments they undertake. They may be used to enable the comparison of activity within and between different organisations and provide an opportunity to benchmark treatments and services to support trend analysis over time.

HRGs were introduced to NHS Wales in April 2000. HRG version 3.5 has been in use since October 2003 in NHS Trusts, Powys Local Health Board and Health Solutions Wales (HSW).

The Information Centre for Health and Social Care in England has worked with various stakeholder groups including clinicians to redesign fundamentally the structure of HRGs. In England, HRG version 4 was introduced for Reference Costs from April 2006 and for National Tariff from April 2009.

In April 2009, WIGSB approved the use of HRG version 4 by HSW for the purpose of grouping APC data.

Description of Change

To introduce HRG version 4 into the NHS Wales Data Dictionary and associated definitions.

The HRG version 4 Grouper works on definitions that have been agreed by NHS England. There are certain data items which have Welsh variations and would generate invalid HRG4 codes. These ungroupable codes will be mapped to existing English codes during the exporting of data into the HRG4 grouper software which will be held in a new infrastructure table. The submitted values of these APC data items held in existing national databases will not be changed.

Actions Required

HSW:

- 1. Introduce the necessary processes and infrastructure to support the use and the publication of HRG version 4 codes for data users.
- 2. Ensure that the current processes and infrastructure to support the use and publication of HRG version 3.5 codes are continued.
- 3. Ensure the mappings details of Welsh values to English values are included on all future HRG4 reports.

Local Health Boards/ Velindre NHS Trust:

- 1. Local Health Boards and Velindre NHS Trust must continue to submit HRG version 3.5 codes in the APC data set. Version 4 codes should not be submitted.
- 2. If organisations wish to use HRG version 4 at a local level they should ensure that they use the mappings described in this DSCN.
