#### **DATA SET CHANGE NOTICE**

#### Introduction

The Outpatient Referrals Data Set (OPR DS) was introduced in 2008 via DSCN (2008) 05 (W)<sup>1</sup> and EH/ML/010/08<sup>2</sup>. Its introduction was designed *"to enhance the information base for referrals into secondary care"*. This data set includes all new clinical referrals received into a Local Health Board (LHB) / Trust for a new outpatient appointment from General Practitioners, General Dental Practitioners, Community Dental Services, A&E Departments, self referrals, walk-ins or emergency patients accompanied by a GP letter and Consultant to Consultant Referrals.

LHBs / Trusts have been required to submit monthly the OPR DS via the NHS Wales Data Switching Service (NWDSS) on the 27th day of each month.

In order for the OPR DS to be used for national reporting, such as the publication of official statistics by the Health Statistics & Analysis Unit, Welsh Government, there is a requirement to change the submission date for the data set.

## **Description of Change**

To change the submission date from the 27<sup>th</sup> to the 14<sup>th</sup> calendar day of each month

# **Data Dictionary Version**

It is noted that the operational processes by which the OPR DS, and other national patient-level data sets, are submitted to NWIS are not fully described in the NHS Wales Data Dictionary. A further Data Dictionary Change Notice (DDCN) will be issued to add the reporting details to the NHS Wales Data Dictionary for all patient-level data sets.

### **Actions Required**

Action for Local Health Boards / Trusts:

- Ensure OPR DS is submitted by the 14<sup>th</sup> calendar day of each month, effective from September 2012 onwards i.e.
  - The first submission of OPR DS is required by Friday 14<sup>th</sup> September 2012, for data relating to 1<sup>st</sup> August 2012 to 31<sup>st</sup> August.

Action for the NHS Wales Informatics Service:

• Ensure that a monthly extract of OPR data is provided to the Health Statistics & Analysis Unit, Welsh Government, using the OPR DS as the source, effective from September 2012 onwards.
