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PURPOSE

The purpose of this document is to describe in detail the recent implementation of data quality checks for substance misuse data, as well as to outline the additional checks which are yet to be added. This should be read in conjunction with the *SM - Data Quality*¹ document which contains a summary of the logic for all checks.

BACKGROUND

Client-level data extracts are submitted to the NHS Wales Informatics Service (NWIS) data warehouse by Substance Misuse Agencies to the using the NHS Wales Data Switching Service (NWDSS). In order to ensure that this data is of sufficient quality to meet reporting needs, it is necessary to employ data integrity checks to validate each data submission.

The Validation at Source Service (VASS) is a facility located on the NHS Wales intranet that enables data providers to identify errors in their dataset extracts at the time of submission to NWDSS. The new checks are designed to ensure that submitting organisations can identify data quality issues prior to formally signing off their data.

Following each submission, Agencies should review their list of errors, correct their source data and resubmit their records. Only when the Agency has resolved their issues and eliminated their errors (where possible) should they sign off their file to allow it to be processed through to the NWIS data warehouse.

These checks will be deployed in three distinct phases:

- **Phase 1** - The first phase implementation contains all of the checks which are critical to preserve the quality of the dataset, which are predominantly **Data Load checks**. Data Load checks are used to protect the integrity of the database by identifying invalid values within a record. If a Data Load error is triggered, the whole record is rejected by the system and will not be processed through to the NWIS data warehouse.
- **Phase 2 - Data Validity checks**. These will test the values submitted in each record against the set of nationally-agreed values described in the NHS Wales Data Dictionary², e.g. Treatment Stage must have a value between 01 and 04. These are due to be deployed on 1st October 2014.
- **Phase 3** - In addition to checking the values submitted in distinct fields, it is also important that relationships between data items are maintained. **Data Consistency checks** build upon the Data Validity checks by testing if related data items are consistent with one another. For example, Date of Birth must be before Date of Referral. This set of checks will be added on 1st January 2015.

Introduction of the Data Validity check for NHS Number will be deferred to Phase 3 to allow the necessary software development to be completed.

The checks included in Phase 1 were deployed prior to the receipt of the first data submissions as these are vital to maintain the integrity of the NWIS data warehouse. This document therefore focuses on the checks applied in Phase 1. A list of the checks and their respective deployment phase is shown in [Annex 1](#). The Phase 1 checks are described in detail in [Annex 2](#).
