DATA SET CHANGE NOTICE

A Data Set Change Notice (DSCN) is an information mandate for a new or revised information standard.

DATA SET CHANGE NOTICE

Introduction

Together for Health: Eye Health Care Delivery Plan was launched by the Minister for Health and Social Services in September 2013. Current policy initiatives are aimed at shifting the treatment of patients from secondary care hospital eye services to treating them in primary care optometric practices whenever appropriate to do so.

Currently about 10% of all outpatients in hospitals are seen in ophthalmology and optometrists refer most of them. However, currently there is no way to measure if these policies are working because referrals from optometrists to ophthalmology are not separately identified.

Capturing referrals, so that primary care optometrists could be separately identified as and when they make a referral into secondary care, would enable these policies to be developed further using evidenced based information.

The Outpatient Data Set may currently include referrals from Optometrists under the value '08 –Other'. These referrals should now be reported via the new value.

The Outpatient Referral Data Set has excluded reporting of '08 – Other' and therefore may not have captured referrals from Optometrists at all. As part of this DSCN we are removing the exclusion of '07 – Prosthetist' and '08 – Other' in order to capture referrals from all sources.

<u>Description of Change</u>

- To include a new value in the data item 'Source of Referral: Outpatients' to identify referrals from Optometrists; and
- To remove current exclusions from the Outpatient Referral Data Set.

Data Dictionary Version

Where applicable, this DSCN reflects changes introduced by DSCN and/or DDCN since the release of version 4.6 of the NHS Wales Data Dictionary.

The changes introduced by such DSCNs will be published in version 4.7 of the NHS Wales Data Dictionary.

Actions Required

Actions for Local Health Boards / Trusts:

 Update local data collection processes within appropriate systems (e.g. PAS) to ensure the appropriate reporting of 'Source of Referral' codes within the Outpatient and Outpatient Referral data set.

Actions for the NHS Wales Informatics Service (NWIS):

- Update national data processing and validation services (e.g. NHS Wales Data Switching and Validation at Source services) to allow for the reporting of the revised values for 'Source of Referral', within the Outpatient and Outpatient Referral data set.
- Ensure all tools associated with the monitoring and reporting of outpatient and outpatient referral activity data validity (e.g. Outpatient Activity Data Validity
