DATA STANDARDS CHANGE NOTICE

Introduction

The Welsh Government's guidance for healthcare practitioners on working effectively with Gypsies and Travellers, entitled 'Travelling to Better Health' identifies the need to collect information relating to the health status of this ethnic category.

The White Gypsy/Irish Traveller ethnic category was included for the first time in the Office for National Statistics 2011 Population Census.

The adoption of the 2011 Census values for ethnic category is therefore key to achieving the requirement for "continued collection of data" and, in turn, ensuring compliance with the objectives set out within this guidance.

Furthermore, the guidance states that "All LHBs and Trusts to have engaged with Welsh Government-led developments to introduce Census 2011 ethnic categories into appropriate local operational systems and central reporting." This is a clear statement in support of the need for this change.

In addition, this requirement formed a key element of the Welsh Government's NHS Outcome Framework¹ for 2016-17, where a number of performance measures are dependent on the collection of information that demonstrates a commitment to improving the health and wellbeing of vulnerable groups, which include Gypsies and Irish Travellers.

Description of Change

Adopt the Office for National Statistics 2011 Population Census list of ethnic categories.

The Maternity Indicators Data Set is not affected by this change as it already uses the 2011 list of ethnic categories.

Data Dictionary Version

Where applicable, this DSCN reflects changes introduced by DSCN and/or DDCN since the release of version 4.9 of the NHS Wales Data Dictionary.

The changes introduced by such DSCNs will be published in version 4.10 of the NHS Wales Data Dictionary.

Actions Required

Local Health Boards / Trusts:

• Health Boards update their systems and reporting processes to enable the collection and submission of the 2011 Census ethnic categories with effect from April 2017.

NHS Wales Informatics Service:

- Update the relevant infrastructure to enable the collection, storage, onward distribution and analysis of all affected data sets.
- Ensure any affected national applications managed by The Informatics Service, are updated.
