DATA STANDARDS CHANGE NOTICE

Introduction

The Diagnostic and Therapy Services Waiting Times Return was first introduced in May 2003. The purpose of the return is to capture waiting times for specified diagnostic and therapy services for the NHS in Wales.

As part of a Welsh Government programme of work to review Cardiac Referral to Treatment Times, the scope of the Diagnostic and Therapy Services Waiting Times Return was extended for a time limited period to include additional diagnostic tests for Cardiology as per DSCN 2015 / 01 (first pilot) and DSCN 2017 / 01 (second pilot)

The reporting of separate waits for the additional diagnostic tests in intended to provide an insight into delays for specific tests that have an impact on overall Cardiac Referral to Treatment Times.

A review of the initial pilot found that the data was not reported consistently across Wales. Some of the additional tests were already being reported under other service headings such as Radiology. Therefore, for the second pilot health boards were required to report the waiting times for additional cardiac tests under both the existing service heading as well as the new Cardiology service heading but NOT to formally report on them in any official statistics publications.

As a result of both pilots, it was agreed to extend the scope of the Diagnostic and Therapies return to officially establish the additional cardiac tests as reportable waits from 1st April 2018, and to provide clarity for some Radiology Sub Specialties so as to specifically refer only to non-cardiac cases and hence remove the danger of double-counting. This will result in the following changes:

Increasing the scope of the Diagnostic and Therapies Waiting Times Return to include the following cardiac tests in official reports:

- Blood Pressure Monitoring*
- Heart Rhythm Recording*
- Cardiac Computed Tomography (Cardiac CT)*
- Cardiac Magnetic Resonance Imaging (Cardiac MRI)*
- Dobutamine Stress Echocardiogram (DSE)*
- Myocardial Perfusion Scanning^{*}
- Diagnostic Angiography*
- Diagnostic Electrophysiology (EP Study)*
- Trans Oesophageal Echocardiogram (TOE)*

and

Amending the following Sub Specialties (within Radiology Specialties) to provide greater clarity:

- Computed Tomography to Non Cardiac Computed Tomography
- Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) to Non Cardiac Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI)
- Nuclear Medicine to Non Cardiac Nuclear Medicine

Data Dictionary Version

Actions Required

Local Health Boards / Trusts:

- Report the cardiology diagnostic tests as they appear in Appendix B from April 1st 2018.
- Apply the additional clarity provided for some Radiology Sub Specialties

NHS Wales Informatics Service:

- Update national data processing and validation services (e.g. NHS Wales Data Switching Service and Validation and Source Services) to allow for the reporting of waits for the additional cardiology service sub-headings within the Diagnostic and Therapy Services Waiting Times Return.
- Provide the pilot waiting times data for the cardiology service sub-headings to the Delivery and Performance Division, Welsh Government on a monthly basis, using the existing extract.

Welsh Government:

- Update process to be able to accept data for the new diagnostic tests.
- Include a note in publications to summarise impact of expected changes.
