#### **DATA STANDARDS CHANGE NOTICE**

#### Introduction

The primary purpose of the Admitted Patient Care (APC) data set is to provide activity figures for admitted care. However, this data set is also used to calculate waiting times for admitted care.

The Legal Status data item under the APC data set was identified for investigation via the IQI working group review process. Issues had previously been raised regarding the variation between the English and Welsh standard legal status values along with needing clarity on reporting of the value in APC. Analysis on usage of the data item showed that majority of Health Boards were not utilising the full list of values and was noted that the item is planned to be part of the upcoming Mental Health data set due to go live in FY 2023/24. The IQI group therefore questioned if the data item should be retired from Admitted Patient Care data set.

Upon receiving written confirmation from all Health Boards that they are happy for this item to be retired, approval was requested from WG.

It has been confirmed that this information is not currently used for any national and local reporting.

#### **Description of Change**

This DSCN officially retires the data item Legal Status from the Admitted Patient Care data set.

#### **Data Dictionary Version**

Where applicable, this DSCN reflects changes introduced by DSCN and/or DDCN since the release of version 4.16 of the NHS Wales Data Dictionary.

The changes introduced by such DSCNs will be published in version 4.17 of the NHS Wales Data Dictionary.

#### **Actions Required**

Actions for Local Health Boards / Trusts:

• Duration of Legal Status field to be populated with spaces to the length format (i.e. two spaces) in the APC data submission with effect from 1st January 2023 (i.e. to be applied to data submitted in February 2023)

Actions for Digital Health and Care Wales:

- Remove the following VASS checks:
  - o 50612: Legal Status vs. Specialty (of Treatment)
  - o 50114: Legal Status
- Remove the entries in Data Validity and Consistency Reports relating to the above VASS checks.

This is a classification of a patient's Legal Status which is either informal or as designated in the Mental Health Act 1983 or other acts. The classification "informal" is

used for those patients who are not formally detained or not receiving supervised aftercare. The classification is required for all patients who have a hospital provider spell which includes the care of a consultant in the psychiatric specialties or have been discharged from such a hospital provider spell and are required to receive supervised aftercare under the provision of the Mental Health (Patients in the Community) Act 1995.

For the APC ds99 this data item became effective from April 1999 and, with the data item Administrative Category, replaced the data item Category of Patient.
